## General Function

Community Event Volunteers are committed to representing Inclusive Communities within the community in a professional capacity. Community Event Volunteers' main responsibility is to connect community members with Inclusive Communities resources and materials, and speak intelligently about our diversity and inclusion programming and volunteer options.

Expected time commitment varies each month depending on available community events. Past Community Events have consisted of Heartland Pride, MAHA Music Festival, Humanitarian Brunch and campus engagement fairs.

## Primary Responsibilities:

- Represent Inclusive Community at community events;
- Engage event participants in and open, meaningful dialogue about diversity and inclusion;
- Speak intelligently about Inclusive Communities' programming
- Attend any trainings required for community programming; and
- Maintain consistent communication with Inclusive Communities Staff.

## Skill knowledge and requirements:

- An overall passion and personal commitment to uphold and respect Inclusive Communities' vision and mission, and to expand that mission in their community;
- Ability to work well with people of all ages;
- Strong grasp of Inclusive Communities' programming content, pedagogy, and values;
- Must have experience interacting and communicating with people from diverse backgrounds, both in groups and individually; and
- Ability to attend 5 monthly Omaha Table Talk.
